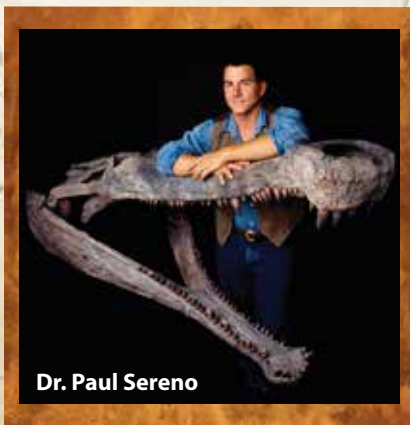
Paleontologist Dr. Paul Sereno, Professor, University of Chicago, Cofounder of Project Exploration, and National Geographic Explorer-in-Residence, led a team on a four-month expedition to the Sahara Desert to uncover Africa's dinosaur world in 2000. SuperCroc was one of the great finds of the expedition.

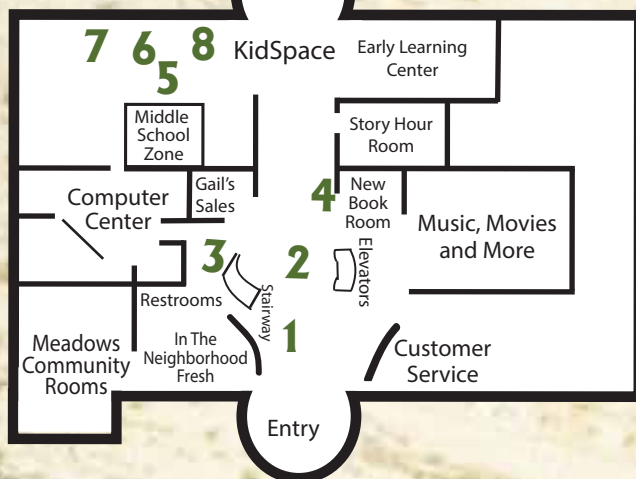

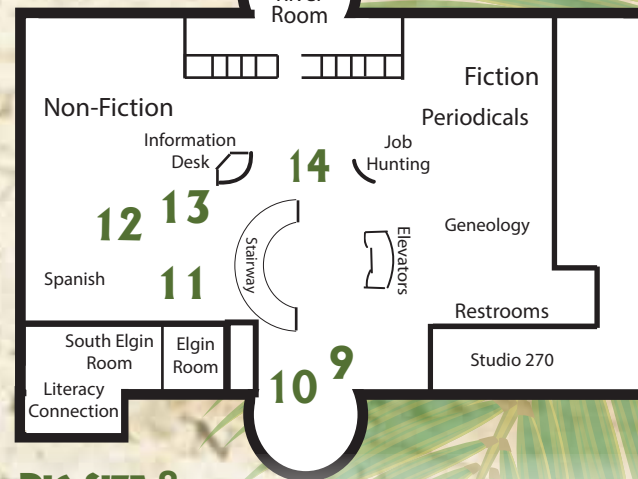
