You **DO NOT** need a Social Security Number to get a vaccine!



### COVID-19 Vaccine Facts for Undocumented Residents



The COVID vaccine is **FREE**, even if you do not have health insurance. You will not be charged for the vaccine.



Undocumented immigrants can get the **COVID vaccine**. No immigration status or social security number is required.



Your information is **confidential**. Vaccine providers may not share your information with ICE or any other immigration official.

The Community Health Workers, as part of the Pandemic Health Navigator Program, offers many free resources in multiple languages to help keep you and your loved ones safe during the pandemic.
